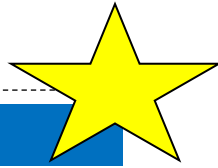


Ferham Primary School

Punctuality is paramount!

The school gates open at 8.40am and close at 8.50am. If your child arrives at school after this time, they're deemed late. It is very important for pupils to be in school on time. If they're persistently late for school, it has detrimental effect on their learning.

It also has an effect on our kitchen staff. They prepare each meal in accordance with how many children are in school having lunch. Any child who arrives after 10am to school will not receive an option for dinner. They will be allocated a meal in accordance with what the staff have prepared.
