Thematic Concepts

- Bread is eaten all over the world.
- Breads are made from grains.
- We can make bread.

- Retell events from a story.

Understanding the World

- Experiment with and gain skills in using a variety of creative art materials.
- Experiment with new media.
- Take on increasingly complex roles and leadership in dramatic play activities.
